

We will be implementing a new process for submitting membership applications and submitting payments.

Here is what will be implemented:

- A new membership application form (SHORT FORM) is now available for current members. The short form only requires you to read and sign the second page of the full application. This will eliminate the need for you to enter all of the information you previously submitted (FAA, AMA, TRUST, etc.). The FULL application form should be used if any of your information personal information has changed.
- An *electronic on-line version* of the membership application forms will be made available in the near future. The on-line version will allow you to fill out the application online and sign it using a secure internet application. This will eliminate the need for you to send in your application by US mail (no envelope or stamps required). We will send out a special email when this option is available.
- We are also looking into setting up *electronic payments to our bank account using the ZELLE application*. This will be an option on the on-line membership application form.
- Membership cards will be provided via email. (NOTE: Paper copies will still be available if requested).

DO NOT SUBMIT COPIES OF 2023 MEMBERSHIP APPLICATIONS. 2024 APPLICATION FORMS ARE AVAILABLE ON THE WRIGHT FLYERS WEB SITE. CLUB OFFICERS WILL HAVE PAPER COPIES OF THE APPLICATION FORMS IF REQUIRED.
